



Results on a Class 4 shingle: No evidence of ruptures or cracks through the shingle immediately after impact.



A cool gray with a beautiful green undertone, Slate coordinates well with both grays and greens, as well as with white, cream, and ivory exteriors.




Hickory

Hickory is the most neutral of shades and works wonderfully with blues, grays, whites, yellow, gold, sage, and green.




Pewter Gray
