What Is The Concern?

The newly released (1/13) *EverGuard® TPO/PVC Mechanically Attached Roofing System Overview & General Requirements Manual...* does **not** include PVC membrane attachment tables for GAF's recently introduced **8'** (2.44m) and **10'** (3.05m) wide PVC sheets.

- As of now, there are only PVC membrane attachment tables for our 76" (1.93m) wide or smaller sheets.

How Can It Affect My Roof?

By using the incorrect attachment table...

- The fastener pull-out values, fastener/plate type and pattern may be incorrect
- Over or under fastening could occur, wasting time, labor and materials
- The required wind rating or uplift pressure resistance could be affected

What Should You Do?

If you are using a 76" (1.93m) wide EverGuard® PVC sheet or smaller...

- **You are fine...** refer to the current *EverGuard® PVC Membrane Attachment Table* within the manual (pages 22-23) and use those values and fastening patterns for your mechanically attached system.

If you are using an 8' (2.44m) or 10' (3.05m) wide EverGuard® PVC sheet...

- Refer to the *EverGuard® TPO Membrane Attachment Table* within the manual (pages 20-21) and use those values and fastening patterns for your mechanically attached system.

What Else Do I Need To Know?

The 8' (2.44m) and 10' (3.05m) wide PVC sheets will be added the attachment tables in the next update of the *EverGuard® TPO/PVC Mechanically Attached Roofing System Overview & General Requirements Manual*.
