

## SHINGLE INSTALLATION

Start at either rake and  
lay in either direction

### First Course:

Start with full shingle.

Trim  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (13mm)  
notch.

### Second Course:

Trim 5" (127mm)  
off first shingle

### Third Course:

Trim 10" (254mm)  
off first shingle

### Fourth Course:

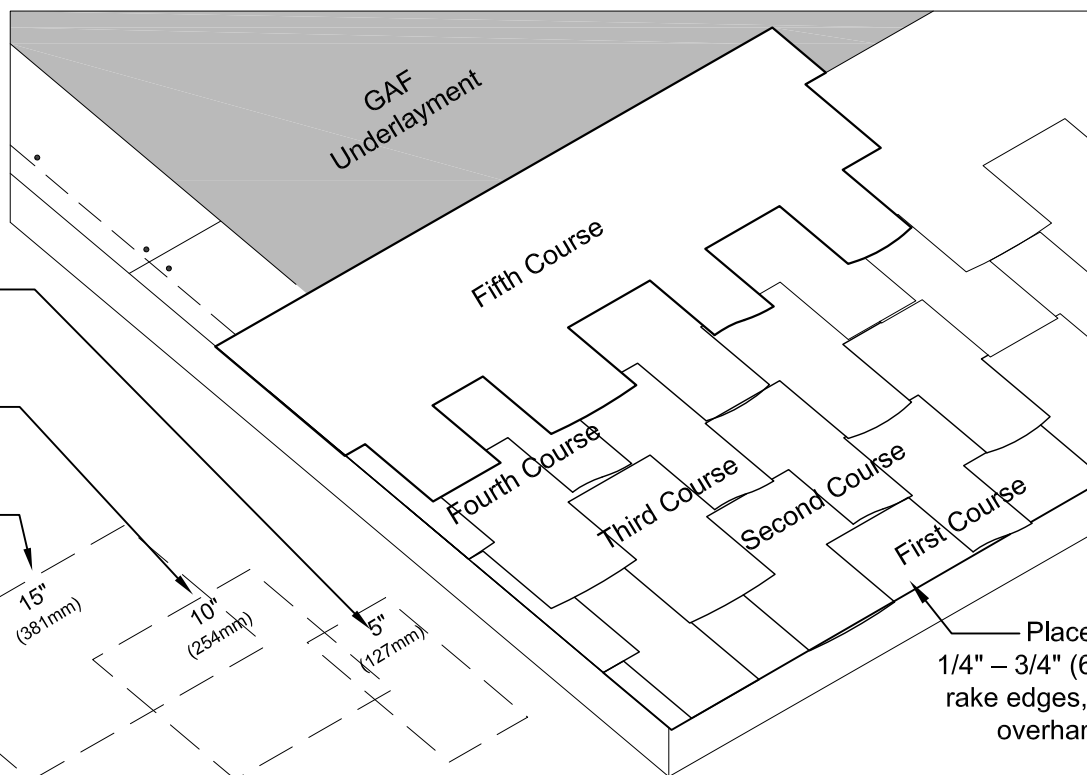
Trim 15" (381mm)  
off first shingle

### Remaining

#### Courses:

Fifth course, trim  
20" (508mm) from  
rake edge, sixth course,  
trim 25" (635mm) from rake  
edge, seventh course, trim 30" (762mm) from rake edge,  
eighth course, trim 35" (889mm) from rake edge, ninth  
course, start with a full shingle and continue previous  
pattern. A full shingle can be used to start any odd  
numbered course if necessary; however, to obtain the  
best appearance, follow instructions above.

**Shingle exposure should be 5" (127 mm).**



## NOTES:

1. Continue each  
course with whole  
shingles.

2. Strike a chalk  
line about every 6  
courses to check  
parallel alignment  
with eaves.

Place first course of shingles  
 $\frac{1}{4}$ " –  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (6–19mm) over eave and  
rake edges, covering starter course  
overhang, to provide drip edge.
