What is WELL?

The WELL Building Standard is a green building rating system created by the International Well Building Institute (IWBI) to help create spaces that enhance human health and well-being. Alignment to this standard is verified through on-site testing of building performance.

How is WELL organized?

WELL comprises 11 categories: air, water, nourishment, light, movement, thermal comfort, sound, materials, mind, community, and innovation.



WELL Certification has 4 tiers: Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Platinum, which all correspond to the number of points achieved.
